TERMS OF TICKET

Refunds given until 15 days before any trip. No refunds after that date unless we can resell your tickets. All refunds subject to \$5.00 service charge. Car assignment made on tickets, every youth and adult ticket holder guaranteed seating, children under 5 must not occupy seat unless available. Sponsor reserves right to refuse accommodation to any passenger for good cause. Ticket includes rail fare as shown, but does not include meals or admittance to any other attraction. Food available on train at reasonable prices. Special passenger requirements, such as wheelchair patients, should be made known well in advance. Please select an alternate date for your reservations, in case primary date is sold out. If only one date is possible for your visit, leave "2nd choice" space blank. Please dress in comfortable, casual, clothing. Women should not wear spiked heels.

The Greenbrier Railroad Company office and Greenbrier Valley Tourist Information Center, located in the former C&O Railway Depot in Ronceverte, will also sell tour tickets and provide additional information about other attractions, lodging, etc.

Cass Short Tour: Tickets for the round trip between Cass and Durbin on each operating Sunday will be sold at \$4.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children ages 5 - 15. These tickets, sold on a space-available basis, are available only on the date of operation from the agent at the Cass Scenic Railroad depot in Cass, WV. Please Note: Passengers from Ronceverte, or Marlinton may elect to ride to Durbin, or to stop over in Cass. However, there will be no adjustment in fare made, and fare for riding the Cass Scenic Railroad is not included in your fare on the Greenbrier Railroad. Your tickets are good for the complete round-trip from point of origin to Durbin, and your option of stopping off at Cass will not entitle you to any refund, as Cass attractions are not connected with the Greenbrier Railroad. For those desiring a shorter tour may we suggest boarding at Marlinton. Thank you.
